- WHAT** An area wide food drive conducted to support agencies who provide food to those in need.
- WHEN** March 1 – March 27, 2010
- HOW** On a district by district basis, packs, troops, teams, crews and posts will distribute bags around local geographical areas with an instructional flyer and a week later, return to collect bags filled with non-perishable food items. Each district will designate a unit drop off location such as a food bank or other agency that will receive collected items.
- The instructional flyers and bags, along with more information will be available at the FEBRUARY roundtable meeting.

- 1) A local church pantry or your chartered organization
- 2) A local community food bank
- 3) Food Bank of Northeast Georgia
- 4) North Gwinnett Co-Op
- 5) Southeast Gwinnett Co-Op
