

Camp Rainey Mountain

Your Troop will arrive at Camp Rainey Mountain on Sunday afternoon for check-in. This is when you will meet your Instructors and Counselors for the week. Later that afternoon you will take your BSA swim test and receive your course materials for the week.

YOU CAMP WITH YOUR TROOP

You are participating in an advanced outdoor Scouting program in which certain skills must be learned before advancing to the next phase of your training. Schedules will be kept flexible.

Prerequisites:

1. Minimum age of 15, a strong swimmer and be able to pass the BSA swim test before camp
2. Completed BSA Medical Form #34605
3. Signed parental consent form (provided with SCUBA material after registering)
4. Completed SSI open water manual prior to arrival (provided with SCUBA material after registration)

Classroom and Confined water (Monday-Tuesday)

Your classroom and water sessions will be held at Camp Rainey Mountain in Clayton, Georgia. Here you will learn to dive using the latest equipment and dive computers. Your diving Instructors are all Scouters themselves, and are the best the industry has to offer. Class size is small so that you receive individualized instruction.

Open water checkout dive (Wednesday – Friday)

Wednesday morning you will load up and travel to Lake Jocassee near Walhalla, South Carolina for your open water checkout dives. This clear lake offers an excellent dive site with little or no boat traffic.

On Thursday, you will return to Lake Jocassee for your final checkout dives.

Friday we travel back to Lake Jocassee to dive the sunken Chinese “Junk”. You will be back at Camp Rainey Mountain by the closing campfire Friday night where you will receive your SCUBA certificates.

Adult Leaders

Adult Leaders who are already certified are welcome to join us for the week. Tank rentals and directions to area dive sites are available in camp and at some of the local dive sites. Sorry, no rental SCUBA equipment is available.
