SCOUTING SHOWCASE INFORMATION

WHO CAN ENTER? This year's University of Scouting is more than just educational classes. We are featuring a Scouting Showcase. Space is reserved for units who wish to present items and ideas of interest. These can include games, challenges, demonstrations, or other ideas you feel are appropriate. Units, who are proud of what they have done or have something unique to share, are particularly encouraged to participate in the Scouting Showcase.

ARE ENTRIES LIMITED TO ONLY UNITS? We absolutely invite the community to sponsor a booth in our Scouting Showcase. We encourage Scout friendly companies such as retailers of camping equipment, patches, or clothing. We look forward to visit booths sponsored by agencies such as the National Forest Service, Trout Unlimited, biking clubs or American Red Cross. Whether your unit is sponsoring a booth or not, we ask each leader to contact local retailers and agencies, similar to those mentioned, to encourage them to participate. The more Scout friendly companies and retailers the better. Better for our participants and better for those retailers and agencies who sponsor a booth, with the 500+ who is expected to be in attendance.

THE DETAILS Each booth sponsor will be given a 10' x 10' space on the Scouting Showcase floor, enough room for a table, flag and 2 volunteers. Unfortunately, electricity cannot be provided. Handout materials, along with contact information for participants to follow up, is a great way for visitors to your booth to stay in contact after the event. Give away items are encourage. For sale items are not permitted.

WHAT TO BRING A six or eight foot table - ideally with a table cloth or equivalent, a unit flag with award ribbons and stand as well as a sign to identify your unit. We encourage your booth to include items of interest and display items you wish to shown off.
