2019 SHOOTING SPORTS EVENT REGISTRATION AT CAMP RAINEY MOUNTAIN NRA - Basic Class

NRA Basic Class - Cost: \$40 Rifle; \$60 Shotgun, RSO \$80

Dates offered: Sept 6,7,8, 2019 (Saturday & Sunday) (arrive Friday night the 6th)

Basic Shotgun or Rifle course participants will get the NRA's The Basics of Shotgun or Rifle Shooting handbook, and intensive lessons in safety, gun handling, fundamentals of shotgun shooting, several practical exercises on the firing range, cleaning, storage, and a summary of shotgun and rifle sports and activities. Both courses will include information about firearm knowledge and safe handling, ammunition knowledge and fundamentals of shooting, and shooting sports and activities. In addition, practical skills will include firing the first shots (includes cleaning and storage), and standing shooting positions (including prone, kneeling, and sitting positions for Rifle.) This course is a required pre-requisite for the NRA Instructor course, which will be held Nov 8,9,10, 2019 and a minimum firearm handling and marksmanship competency must be demonstrated to successfully complete the course. More information about the courses of fire, written testing, etc. will be provided during the course. There are no provisions made for youth that are not participating in the course.

September 7, 2019 at Camp Rainey Mountain

Course fee includes all training materials. Plan to arrive Friday night, classes begin Saturday morning at 8am and should conclude by 5pm. Participants will be housed in the lower staff area – bring bedding, meals and personal items. No uniform required. Check in at admin building between 7 and 9pm Friday night.

USA Archery LVL I Certification Class – Cost \$85.00

This course is an introduction on how to teach archery on a basic level. Intended to teach Archery Instructors in Scouts, 4-H, Summer Camps, and other programs. Teaching beginning archers to be safe with Archery Equipment while on the range. Learn how to teach basic form and steps of shooting to get archers on target in and organized format. You will be able to teach archers safely while they learn skills for competition or to just fun. Class does have hands on range training and a written test at end. No prerequisite, no membership cost, no experience needed. Participant must be 15 yrs old to take this class. SAFE sport training must be completed online before certification is complete.
