

2019 Northeast Georgia Scout Show CHILI COOK-OFF GUIDELINES:

- 1. Set-up will take place from 7:00am -9:00am on Saturday, April 20th, the tasting and judging will take place from 11:00am-2:00pm. A site map with your location will be emailed to you the week prior to the event.**
- 2. Spaces are approximately 10X10 and must be accommodated by a 10X10 canopy.**
- 3. You are required to bring your own tables, chairs, and canopy.**
- 4. You MUST KEEP YOUR CHILI HOT (health department regulations), to do this you need to use a gas gills, camp stove or a portable propane stove.**
- 5. Electricity and Water are not available on site**
- 6. Each unit must provide their own material such as: plastic trash bags, water, towels, soap, and a card with a description show if chili (ex. vegetarian, meat, hot, mild, etc)**
- 7. All displays, and booth decorations must be suitable for our family event. Judging will take place for booth decoration**
- 8. General Public Admittance will begin at 8:00am, tasting will begin at 11:00am and run until 2:00pm, with the winner announced after the COUNCIL PINE WOOD DERBY RACE at approximately 4:00pm.**
- 9. Tasting cups, Spoons, and Napkins will be provided by Northeast Georgia Council Boy Scouts of America. Please bring your own food handlers, gloves, and washing stations**
- 10. All Vehicles must be removed from site immediately after set-up. Parking will be available in the appropriate marked lots.**
- 11. Booth Space clean-up is the responsibility of the participant(s)**
- 12. Northeast Georgia Boy Scouts of America assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or claim arising out of the participants acts or omissions during this event**
- 13. The following will be the categories in which the chili will be judged:**
 - a. Most Unique**
 - b. Sponsors' Choice**
 - c. Peoples' Choice**
- 14. All categories will have a 1st/2nd/3rd place winner.**
