I. To access the E-Lawroom BSA Harassment Prevention Training:

Seasonal Staff Harassment Prevention Training

Boy Scouts of America maintains a respectful and safe workplace for all employees, therefore it is equally important that all seasonal staff complete Harassment Prevention Training as it is for our full-time staff. The recent updates for Harassment Prevention Training content have resulted in a new link for seasonal staff to complete the required training. Seasonal employees will use the link below to log into the BSA Skillsoft Academy to access the training:

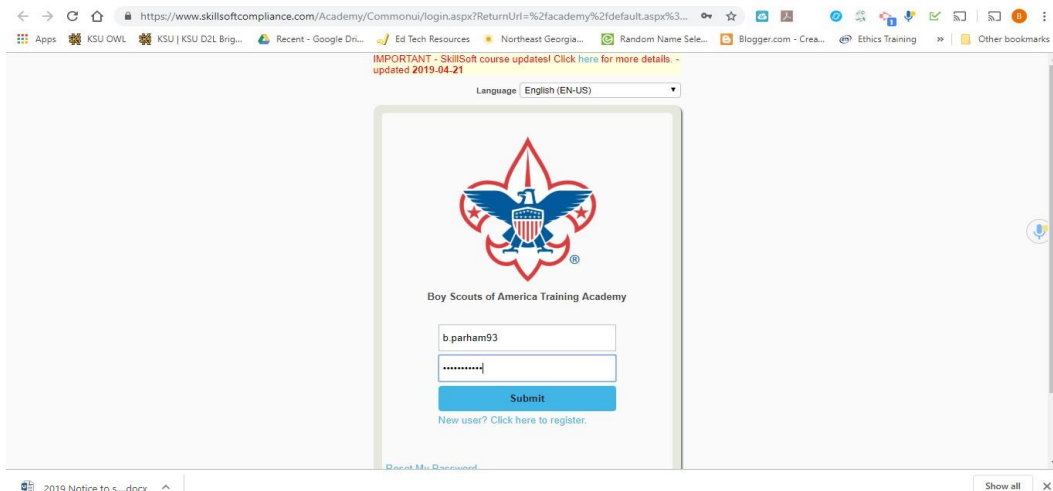

Seasonal employees will select if they are in a manager or employee role and the correct training will automatically be assigned to them. They will also select their council name or high adventure base so that reports can be generated by the site.

It is recommended that seasonal employees print a certificate of completion at the end of the training and that the certificate is collected as part of the pre-employment paperwork.


Make sure to sign-in using your BSA Member ID information.



II. To access the BSA Youth Protection Training

1) Go to my.scouting.org. Using your my.Scouting log In information, sign in to your account. If you do not have an account with my.Scouting, you will need to click the "Create Account" button on the left hand side.

2) You will be directed to the screen that looks just like the one below. Click on the "Youth Protection Begins with You" Badge on the right side of the screen.



V. Leave No Trace Online Training


1. Go to <https://Int.org/get-involved/training-courses/online-awareness-course/>.
