This one-day event will make available registered merit badge counselors for the Archery merit badge along with staffed Archery ranges. **All participants should come prepared by having read the appropriate merit badge pamphlet and bringing with them all necessary materials outlined in the requirements.** Shooting opportunities will be available using USA Archery Certified Instructors to score targets and assist Scouts to learn techniques that will improve their performance. Cost includes use of bow & arrows and targets. If a Scout comes prepared with the knowledge necessary to discuss the requirements to the satisfaction of the counselor, a signed blue card from their Unit Leader and shoots a minimum score, they can complete all requirements on this day for the Archery Merit Badge.
