



USA Archery LVL I & LVL II Classes

Oct 17,18, 2020 at Camp Rainey Mountain

Course fee includes all meals on Sat & Sunday (bring dinner for Friday night) and all training materials.

Participants will be housed in the Cleveland Camp Site – bring bedding and personal items.

No uniform required

Level 1 classes begin on Saturday morning at 8am and conclude about 5pm

Level 2 classes begin on Saturday morning at 8am and conclude on Sunday about 5pm

USA Archery LVL I Certification Class – Cost \$85.00

This course is an introduction on how to teach archery on a basic level. Intended to teach Archery Instructors in Scouts, 4-H, Summer Camps, and other programs. Teaching beginning archers to be safe with Archery Equipment while on the range. Learn how to teach basic form and steps of shooting to get archers on target in and organized format. You will be able to teach archers safely while they learn skills for competition or to just fun. Class does have hands on range training and a written test at end. No prerequisite, no membership cost, no experience needed. Participant must be 15 yrs old to take this class. SAFE sport training must be completed online before certification is complete. (Free class)

USA Archery LVL II Certification Class – Cost \$180

This course is designed to further instructor knowledge in the National Training System for Archery, work with more advanced equipment, and learn different formats of Archery. Intended to teach an Archery Instructor how to improve an archer’s skill in groups including JOAD, Hunters, Competitions, and Intermediate Archers. Learn to improve archers form and shooting technique based on biomechanical techniques.

Learn different types of Archery equipment and proper set-up for intended use. Learn to plan long term programs and minor competitions for Intermediate Archers. Learn how to plan, organize, and run LVL I Instructor Classes.
