The Young American Award

Background:

First presented in 1968, the award is given to young adults who have achieved exceptional excellence in such fields as art, athletics, business, community service, education, government, humanities, literature, music, religion, or science. Who have been involved in service to their community, state, or country that adds to the quality of life and who have maintained an above-average scholastic grade point average. \$1,000 in scholarship money is distributed locally to deserving Young American Award winners.

How to Apply

Applications are sent to the Northeast Georgia Council, which selects those to be honored. A group of community volunteers and educators will select the recipient(s).

Qualifications (all must be met)

- Be a graduating senior (from High School) in 2020.
- Be currently registered with the Northeast Georgia Council in a Crew, Post, Ship or Troop, or as an adult leader.
- One page essay attached explaining your goals and why you should receive the Young American Award.
- Have achieved exceptional excellence in one or more such fields as art, athletics, business, community service, education, government, humanities, literature, music, religion, or science.
- Have been involved in service to their community, state, or country that adds to the quality of life.
- Have maintained an above-average scholastic grade point average. Provide a copy of current school transcript with application.
- Provide at least three (3) letters of recommendation from troop, post, crew, or group leader, individual, teacher, counselor, employer, civic, professional, or community leader, etc. with the application.
