NRA INSTRUCTOR COURSE REGISTRATION AT CAMP RAINEY MOUNTAIN

NRA Instructor Courses - Firearms Instructor - Rifle OR Shotgun - Cost \$100 / RSO - COST \$80.00 (may select only one)

This event will provide training to lead courses in Rifle or Shotgun, or become a Range Safety Officer (RSO.) Upon satisfactory completion, the participant may qualify by NRA standards to instruct in that discipline subject to the stipulations of the NRA.

The courses are designed to train experienced shooters how to lead the NRA Basic or First Steps course for a single discipline as NRA certified instructors. Additionally, you will be able to conduct these courses outside of the Boy Scout programs. Your certification does not automatically allow you to sign off as a merit badge counselor for the rifle or shotgun shooting merit badges. To do so you must first register and be approved as a Rifle/Shotgun Merit Badge Counselor by the Council Advancement Committee. The RSO course offers practical and didactic education on range safety procedures and situations, culminating in a live exercise to complete the training course on the range.

Participants are NOT required to become members of the NRA (although it's highly recommended) as certified instructors; however, your training certification is good for one year and will require additional fees (about \$50) payable to the NRA at the completion of the course to register you as an NRA Instructor. Please bring a blank check with you. If you are a current NRA member, bring your membership number with you.

Per NRA policies, this course is available in English only, and participants are required to have solid English proficiency.
