Upon satisfactory completion, the participant may qualify by NRA standards to instruct in that discipline subject to the age stipulations of the NRA. The courses are designed to train experienced shooters how to lead the NRA Basic or First Steps course for a single discipline as NRA certified instructors. Additionally, you will be able to conduct these courses outside of the Boy Scout programs. **Your certification does not automatically allow you to sign off as a merit badge counselor for the rifle or shotgun merit badge.** To do so, you must first register and be approved as a Rifle or Shotgun Merit Badge Counselor by the Council Advancement Committee. Participants are NOT required to become members of the NRA as certified instructors; however, your initial training certification is good for one year and will require additional fees (about \$50) payable to the NRA at the completion of the course to register you as an NRA Instructor. Please bring a blank check with you. If you are a current NRA member, bring your membership number with you. As you are receiving a significant discount for taking this course through the BSA, you are expected to assist with classes offered by the Council once you have completed the class.

There are no provisions made for youth that are not participating in the course.
