Requirements for the Spark Plug Award

Award Definition:

The award is given to someone who provides Scouting Spirit to the program, one who does more than expected or necessary, a person who inspires youth and adults alike. The award should not be given to a person who does only a good job in an assigned position.

- The award is administered by the Roundtable Commissioner Team.
- The **Spark Plug Award** is reserved for unit (pack, troop, crew, or post) leaders.
- The award may be given to one registered unit leader per month. In the event the Roundtable does not meet in any month, that month's award will be taken up at the for the next Scheduled Roundtable. A nomination will remain in effect until it has been presented to the Commissioner Team three (3) consecutive times.
- The award cannot be shared.
- The nomination must be made in writing, using this form.
- The signature of a registered Scouter is necessary on the nomination. A youth member may prepare the nomination, but it must still have an adult signature.
- This award does not take the place of any Council or District Awards.
- Qualifications:
 - The nominee must be a currently registered Scouter.
 - The nominee must be active and fulfilling his or her duties in their registered position.
 - The nominee must be doing an exceptional job in their registered position or have additional activities other than their registered position.
 - This award can be earned more than once, but for the second award, performance must be **really outstanding**.
