NRA Basic Class

Cost: \$40 Rifle; \$60 Shotgun, or RSO \$80

Basic Pistol, Shotgun, or Rifle course participants will receive the NRA's *The Basics of Shotgun or Rifle Shooting* handbook. RSO students will receive the **NRA Range Safety Officer Course Manual**. These courses will include lessons in safety, gun handling, fundamentals of shooting, cleaning, storage, shotgun or rifle sports and activities, and practical exercises on the firing range. In addition, practical skills will include cleaning, storage, and shooting positions, including prone, kneeling, and standing positions (for Rifle). **The NRA Basic course is a required prerequisite for the NRA Instructor course, and safe firearm handling and marksmanship competency must be demonstrated to successfully complete the course.** More information about the courses of fire and the written test will be provided during the course.

This class is available to adults and youth aged 14 years and up.

There are no provisions made for youth who are not participating in the course.

****Per NRA policies, this course is available to US citizens, in English only, and participants must have solid English proficiency.**

The reservation form, along with all fees paid, must be submitted to the Jefferson Service Center or online **no later than February 14, 2026**, to allow for instructors and instructional material to be available.

Registration fees cannot be collected at the event.

Participants may be assigned adirondacks in Cleveland Campsite based on the number of attendees upon registration.

Participants must bring their own bedding and personal gear. All course materials will be provided..

Meals are **NOT** included. Participants are responsible for all their meals. Uniforms are not required.

Participants should expect to arrive on Friday night and check for class info at the Admin Building between 7-9 pm to determine class start time and location, as classes begin promptly on Saturday morning.

As with all BSA activities, youth protection training is required of all adult leaders in attendance. Please bring proof of current YPT, as this is the ticket to entry.. As a high adventure program participant, the BSA medical form parts A, B, and C must be completed. Please bring a current BSA med form with you.

Only council- or district-owned equipment may be used on Archery, Rifle, and Shotgun ranges. Personally owned equipment is expressly prohibited on a Cub Scout range. All Rifles, Archery, and Shotgun equipment are owned by the NEGA Council. No personally owned firearms are allowed on any Scouting range while Rifles, Archery, and Shotgun activities are in progress.
