NRA Instructor Courses - Firearms Instructor – Rifle, Shotgun - Cost \$100 (may select only one)

This event will provide training to lead courses in Rifle or Shotgun. Upon satisfactory completion, the participant may qualify by NRA standards to instruct in that discipline, subject to the age stipulations of the NRA.

This class will provide training to lead courses in Rifle or Shotgun. Upon satisfactory completion, the participant may qualify by NRA standards to instruct in that discipline, subject to the age stipulations of the NRA. The courses are designed to train experienced shooters how to lead the NRA Basic or First Steps course for a single discipline as NRA-certified instructors. Additionally, you will be able to conduct these courses outside of the Boy Scout programs. **Your certification does not automatically allow you to sign off as a merit badge counselor for the rifle or shotgun merit badge.** To do so, you must first register and be approved as a Rifle or Shotgun Merit Badge Counselor by the Council Advancement Committee. *Participants are NOT required to become members of the NRA as certified instructors.* Your initial training certification will require additional fees payable to the NRA at the completion of the course to register you as an NRA Instructor online. **If you are a current NRA member, bring your membership number with you.** As you are receiving a significant discount for taking this course through the BSA, you are expected to assist with classes offered by the Council once you have successfully completed the class.

This class is available to adults and youth aged 14 years and up.

There are no provisions made for youth who are not participating in the course.

****Per NRA policies, this course is available to US citizens, in English only, and participants must have solid English proficiency.****

This reservation form, along with all fees paid must be submitted to the Jefferson Service Center **no later than April 3, 2025**, to allow for instructors and instructional material to be available.

Registration fees cannot be collected at the event.

Participants may be assigned to adirondacks in Cleveland campsite based on the number of attendees upon registration.

Participants must provide their meals, bedding, and personal gear. All course materials will be provided.

Meals are **not** included. Participants are responsible for all their meals.

Uniforms are not required.

As with all BSA activities, youth protection training is required of all adult leaders in attendance. Please bring proof of current YPT. As a high adventure program leader, the BSA medical form parts A, B, and C must be completed.

Please bring a current BSA med form with you.

Participants should expect to arrive on Friday and check in at the admin building to determine the class location.
Schedule: Friday afternoon/ evening: Basic Instructor Course. Saturday – Sunday: Discipline-specific training.

You must be present for the entire class to receive credit.

Only council- or district-owned equipment may be used on Archery, Rifle, and Shotgun ranges. Personally owned equipment is expressly prohibited on a Scout range. All Rifles, Archery, and Shotgun equipment are owned by the NEGA Council. No personally owned firearms are allowed on any Scouting range while Rifles, Archery, and Shotgun activities are in progress.
