Youth OA election team will visit one of your regular Troop meetings between Nov.-Feb.
Eligible youth are elected by their peers based on character.

Youth Requirements:

1. Approval of his unit leader prior to the election.
2. Boy Scout or Varsity Scout must be registered with the Boy Scouts of America.
3. Hold the First Class rank of the Boy Scouts of America, as a minimum.
4. After registration with a troop or team, have experienced 15 days and nights of Boy Scout camping during the two-year period prior to the election. The 15 days and nights must include one, but no more than one, long-term camp consisting of six consecutive days and five nights of resident camping.

Adult Nominations:

1. Unit Leader and Committee approval
2. Currently registered with Boy Scouts of America
3. Meet same camping requirements as youth.
4. Each Unit allowed to nominate a 1:3 ratio (rounded up) of adults:youth
5. Scoutmasters with tenure of at least 12 months, not included in ratio.
